Chairman Donaldson called the meeting to order at the Shelby County Services Building, asking Mr. Brasher to give the invocation.

Board members present were Mr. Donaldson, Mr. Brasher, Mr. Martin, and Mr. Weatherford.

Mr. Donaldson stated that the purpose of the meeting was due to a request by the Sheriff to approve the results from the Lieutenant's Examination.
