

**Shelby County Law Enforcement Personnel Board**  
**Regular Meeting**  
**September 15, 2009, 6:30 p.m.**

Chairman Mitchell called the monthly meeting to order in the Sheriff's Office Training Center. Mr. Brasher gave the invocation.

Mr. Donaldson moved to accept as written the minutes from the August 18 regular meeting and the August 27 special meeting. Mr. Martin seconded the motion and it carried.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Mr. Weatherford moved to accept as posted the proposed new wording for the section of Rule 7.05(a) concerning requirements for taking promotional examinations. Mr. Brasher seconded, and the motion passed. This action was the first vote for this change and will require another vote at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board in order for the change to become effective.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Mr. Martin moved to accept the secretary's time sheets and mileage. Mr. Weatherford seconded the motion and it carried.

Mr. Donaldson moved for a zero percent Cost-Of-Living Adjustment for the employees for fiscal year 2009-2010. Mr. Weatherford seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

A list of eight (8) Sheriff's Office employees who were approved for step raises by Sheriff Curry was provided to the LEPB as FYI.

The Board reviewed college transcripts submitted for Deputy Derek C. Dixon and Corrections Officer Shanna K. Young for consideration. Deputy Dixon graduated from Faulkner University with a bachelor of science degree in criminal justice. Officer Young graduated from the University of Alabama with a bachelor of arts degree in criminal

justice. Mr. Donaldson moved to approve a ten percent educational incentive for each. Mr. Weatherford seconded and the motion passed.

The following bills were considered and approved for payment: two months on the Auburn-Montgomery contract totaling \$17,383.23, IPMA for \$2,588.22, AT&T for \$12.85, and Office Depot for \$199.26.
